<p><b>Merrimack Valley Regional Transit Authority (MVRTA )</b>  <a href="http://www.mvrta.com/">http://www.mvrta.com/</a></p>	<p><b>Fixed bus route service</b> \$1.25 cash one-way (\$1 with CharlieCard)          Free for children 5 and under with adults          Reduced Fare: \$0.60 cash (\$0.50 with CharlieCard)—only for passengers 60+, passengers with disabilities, passengers with valid Medicare Card, Students (13-17), Children (6-12), Passengers with Statewide Access Pass</p> <p><b>Boston Commuter Bus</b> \$6 cash one-way (\$5 with CharlieCard)</p> <p><b>Ring &amp; Ride</b>—door-to-door transportation for residents of Boxford, Georgetown, Groveland, Newbury/Byfield and West Newbury to anywhere within those towns, Amesbury, Haverhill, Lawrence, Methuen, North Andover, and to the Train Station and Market Basket in Rowley</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Full fare \$1.25, Senior Citizen fare \$0.60</li> <li>● Includes wheelchair access</li> <li>● Call (978) 469-6878 (ext. 3) with contact, drop-off and pick-up information at least 1 day in advance to reserve</li> <li>● Weekdays 5 AM-7 PM, Saturday 9 AM-6 PM</li> </ul> <p><b>Boston/Peabody Medi-Ride</b>—request service for MVRTA Special Services passengers that provides Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday Services from Merrimack Valley to Boston hospitals and Lahey Clinic in Peabody</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Must complete Special Services App (same as EZ Trans) to register</li> <li>● \$8 cash one-way, \$16 cash round-trip</li> <li>● Call (978) 469-6878 (#3) at least 1 week in advance to reserve trip and request companion transport (space-dependent, extra \$4 each way)</li> <li>● Picks up in Greater Lawrence on Tuesdays</li> </ul> <p><b>EZ Trans</b>—transportation for those with disabilities or 60+</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Application required, fare varies depending on destination</li> <li>● Call (877) 308-7267 or (978) 469-6878 (ext. 3) at least 1 day in advance to reserve trip (Monday-Friday, 8AM – 4:30 PM)</li> </ul>

<p><b>MassHealth Prescription for Transportation PT-1</b>  <a href="https://masshealth.ehs.state.ma.us/cwp/login.aspx">https://masshealth.ehs.state.ma.us/cwp/login.aspx</a></p>	<p>A non-emergency transportation to and from Mass Health covered services (doctor’s appointments, counseling, rehabilitation) when the patient is unable to access public or private transportation.  Must be signed by a healthcare provider  <b>Plans with transportation coverage:</b> Standard, CommonHealth, CarePlus  *Make appt. with CSS to register for service   Eligibility: patient does not have access to private transportation and has a medical condition that prevents him/her from using public transportation.</p>
<p><b>United Health Care (UHC) Evercare (Now called Senior Care Options)</b>  <a href="http://www.uhcommunityplan.com/">http://www.uhcommunityplan.com/</a></p>	<p>Free transportation to doctor appointments, pharmacy, approved medical sites for those with this plan</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Transportation Reservation</b> 1-866-428-1967</li> </ul>
<p><b>Charlie Card</b></p>	<p>CharlieCards, the most affordable option are reusable plastic cards that can be loaded with cash value or 1-day, 7-day, or monthly passes.
